We'll visit the graves, among others, of the man who nearly killed Andrew Jackson; the man who is best remembered as a leader of the Corps of Discovery; the woman who lost a landmark Supreme Court voting rights case; the builder of the oldest extant bridge across the Mississippi; the beer baron who's buried in Gothic splendor; and the riverboat pilot who gave Samuel Clemens his *nom de plume*.
